

NOTICE

KEY SECTIONS OF BYLAW NUMBER 3/2007 ARE HEREBY OUTLINED FOR YOUR CONVENIENCE. THIS INFORMATION IN NO WAY PRESENTS A COMPLETE REFERENCE TO THE SPECIFIC BYLAW IN PLACE.

Pursuant to Bylaw Number 3/2007 of the Town of Rose Valley the following dogs have been declared Prohibited Dogs:

1. any Doberman Pinscher
2. any Staffordshire bull terrier;
3. any American Staffordshire bull terrier;
4. any American pit bull terrier;
5. any Rottweiler;
6. Any dog that has an appearance and physical characteristics that are substantially similar to those of any dog referred to above;
7. Any dog identified, as a dog referred to above, by its physical characteristics by a Veterinarian licensed to practice in the Province of Saskatchewan.

In general terms this includes any cross breeds of those dogs referred to in class 1 to 5.

“Dog” means and includes every dog of either sex and any age and shall include pups over eight (8) weeks of age not spayed or neutered and any female dog that has been spayed and any male dog that has been neutered.

Pursuant to section 3.2 of Bylaw Number 3/2007 No person shall keep, possess, or harbour any Prohibited Dog within the boundaries of the Town of Rose Valley.

Every person who contravenes any provision of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction, in the case of an individual or a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00 and in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$25.00 for each day during which the offence continues. To avoid such penalty any person who receives a Notice of Violation of this Bylaw may choose to

1. As specified in the Notice of Violation comply with the bylaw & make voluntary payment, by
 - a) removing said dog from the Town of Rose Valley; and
 - b) paying a fine of \$250.00;or
2. exercise his right to defend any charge of committing a contravention of any of the provisions of this Bylaw.

Any dog which is deemed a prohibited dog and that was not licensed in the Town of Rose Valley as a Restricted Dog by November 10, 2007 must be removed from the Town of Rose Valley.
