

Rose Valley Campground Clients Take Notice

Due to the rising costs of operating and maintaining the Rose Valley Campground, the Council of the Town of Rose Valley has enacted the following fees and regulations pursuant to Bylaw 2 / 2019, the Rose Valley Campground Bylaw 2019

1. **Definitions: In this bylaw**
 - a. **Campground means the Rose Valley Campground located at 117 McCallum Street.**
 - b. **Client means a member of the public who is allowed to use the campground**
 - c. **Extended stay client means a client staying longer than one week in the campground**
 - d. **Campsite means the plot of ground designated for placement of a recreational vehicle or tents.**
2. **The campground has 4 designated campsites each serviced by power. However power to a campsite will only be turned on when fees are paid.**
3. **Campground site rental is a first-come, first-serve basis. Campsites shall not be reserved.**
4. **Use of the facilities is on an “as is” basis.**
5. **An individual campsite may be used for**
 - a. **One recreational vehicle; or**
 - b. **One recreational vehicle and a tent; or**
 - c. **Multiple tents**
6. **The following fees shall apply per campsite and such campsite fees shall not be prorated.**

Length of Time using the campsite	Rental fee	Fees are Due
Per Day	\$10 (ten dollars)	Immediately on Day 1 of rental
Per Week	\$50 (fifty dollars)	Prepaid on Day 1 of rental
Per Month	\$200 (two hundred dollars)	Prepaid on Day 1 of rental

7. **Fees shall be paid at the Town Office during regular Office hours.**
The Rose Valley Town Office is located at 217 Centre Street.
The contact number for the Town Office is 306-322-2232.
Regular Office Hours are 10 am to noon 1 pm to 4 pm.
Fees may be paid by cash or etransfer at the Town Office.
Extended stay clients may pay by cheque.

Alternate contact will be provided on the Town voice mail server for Administrative extended absence (vacation, medical leave etc.), so please phone 306-322-2232 and follow the instructions if you receive an extended absence message.

8. **Power to the campsite will only be turned on upon receipt of payment of campsite fees and only during regular office hours.**

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9. All grey/black water must be contained. If disposing at the campground such water must be disposed of at the trailer sewage disposal. Disposal of grey / black water on the ground is prohibited.
10. Campsites must be kept clean and tidy with no garbage or debris loose on the grounds.
11. Garbage shall be placed in the provided grey waste carts.
 - a. Please put your garbage in garbage bags.
 - b. Extended stay clients are required to place garbage carts out for pickup by 7 am on Wednesday. Carts shall be placed on the campsite access road with wheels to the campsite and 4 feet between the cart and all objects.
 - c. Loraas Disposal picks garbage and recycling carts on a biweekly basis please note if it is a recycle date the garbage will not be picked. Extended stay clients may obtain a Loraas pickup schedule from the Town Office or access the schedule on the Town website – Public Notice tab. If you do not have the schedule please set out the garbage cart for pick up on Wednesday to avoid missing the garbage pickup date.
12. Recycling carts will be available on the campground and placing garbage in recycling carts is prohibited.
13. Open fires are not allowed.
14. Pets must be kept leashed and controlled at all times. Pet feces must be cleaned up and bagged immediately. Please, do NOT dispose of un-bagged pet feces in the cart.
15. Setting off fireworks is prohibited within the campground.
16. All bylaws enacted within the Town of Rose Valley apply to the campground.
17. Campsites are maintained (mowed) as necessary as determined by Public Works. Generally mowing will occur WEEKLY on THURSDAY weather permitting.
 - a. Clients are required to ensure all personal property is properly store or removed to allow unrestricted operation of a riding lawn mower during maintenance.
 - b. The Town is not responsible for damage to any property left on the campsite during maintenance.
18. Contravention of any section of this bylaw may result in eviction.
19. Eviction notice may be served by personal delivery or posting on the recreational vehicle or shelter.
20. In case of eviction all fees paid are forfeit.
